Athletic Program

• Athletes must have a current physical on file. (He/she may not practice or play until the current physical is on file.)

- Many opportunities to volunteer through our Athletic Program: volunteersignup.org/BEP9R
- Registration for spring sports is now open. https://tshq.bluesombrero.com/Default.aspx?tabid=1772850
- If a student athlete is not in school he/she may not play in a game or practice on any day that he/she is not in school.
- If the school has a weather-related or emergency closing, no after school practices or games may take place.
- Any student attending games needs to be accompanied by an adult and is expected to be in the gym watching the games and not in the lobby. Appropriate behavior is expected at all times.
- All coaches and assistant coaches must complete all Virtus volunteer requirements (www.qrschool.org Parent Tab/ Volunteer). In addition, the online concussion training needs to be taken and the certificate turned in to school.
- Eligibility will be run weekly for players in grades 5-8. If a student is placed on supervision, he/she may practice and play. However, a student who is placed on suspension may not play or practice.
