Dear Parent/Guardian:

Our April Cougar Spirit day will take place tomorrow, Friday, April 5. The solar eclipse takes place on Monday, April 8. Our school is planning to provide an opportunity for students to experience this unusual event. Students who have permission are going to be provided with eclipse-safe glasses that meet the ISO 123-2 safety standards. No other devices will be permitted.

Each child received a Solar Eclipse Viewing permission form. The forms are due today, Thursday, April 4. The form asks you to indicate if your child will be allowed/not allowed to participate in the viewing. Only students with the signed permission forms will be allowed to participate in the outside activity. Athletic Program

- If a student athlete is not in school he/she may not play in a game or practice on any day that he/she is not in school.
- Athletes must have a current physical on file. (He/she may not practice or play until the current physical is on file.)

- If the school has a weather-related or emergency closing, no after school practices or games may take place.
- Any student attending games needs to be accompanied by an adult and is expected to be in the gym watching the games and not in the lobby. Appropriate behavior is expected at all times.
- All coaches and assistant coaches must complete all Virtus volunteer requirements (www.qrschool.org Parent Tab/ Volunteer). In addition, the online concussion training needs to be taken and the certificate turned in to school.
- Eligibility will be run weekly for players in grades 5-8. If a student is placed on supervision, he/she may practice and play. However, a student who is placed on suspension may not play or practice.
